

## CUHCC COVID-19 Vaccine Recommendation Guide

COVID-19 VACCINE MIX & MATCH BOOSTER DOSE SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATIONS	
Vaccine & Population Category	CDC recommendation
Pfizer & Moderna recipients falling into one of the authorized booster categories	May mix & match a booster dose of Moderna (half-dose), Pfizer, or Janssen <b>at least 6 months</b> after completing their primary vaccination, if indicated following Booster Flowchart below
Janssen recipients 18+ years of age	May mix & match a booster dose of Moderna (half-dose), Pfizer, or Janssen <b>at least 2 months</b> after completing their primary vaccination, if indicated following Booster Flowchart below

### 3rd Dose Moderna/Pfizer for Immunocompromised Patients - Minimum 28 days after 2nd dose

- Receiving active cancer treatment for tumors or cancers of the blood
- Received organ transplant AND are taking medicine to suppress immune system
- Received stem cell transplant w/in the last 2 years OR are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Mod-severe primary immunodeficiency (DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome)
- Advanced or untreated HIV Infection
- Active treatment with high dose corticosteroids (High-dose corticosteroids in  $\geq 2\text{mg/kg/day}$  or  $\geq 20\text{mg/day}$  of prednisone or prednisone equivalents for  $>2$  weeks) or other immunosuppressive drugs)

### COVID-19 BOOSTER DOSE SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATIONS

Vaccine	Eligible Group	CDC recommendation for Booster
Janssen	18+ years old	<b>At least 2 months after</b> the completion of the single-dose primary regimen, eligible for mix and match
Moderna or Pfizer	Residents in <a href="#">long-term care settings</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Skilled nursing and nursing homes</li> <li>● Residential settings for people with disabilities and older adults, including group homes, shared living, adult foster care, and transitional housing</li> <li>● Assisted living, intermediate care, residential care, or independent living facilities for older adults or people with disabilities</li> <li>● Retirement communities, senior housing, personal care homes, board and care homes</li> <li>● Inpatient or residential setting for people with psychiatric or substance use disorders</li> <li>● Congregate day programs, including adult day programs or other community-based day service programs</li> <li>● Senior center programs and congregate nutrition programs</li> </ul>
	People aged 18-64	<b>CDC endorsed Medical Conditions:</b> Cancer (if did not meet 3 <sup>rd</sup> dose criteria), Chronic Kidney Disease, COPD, asthma, interstitial lung disease, cystic fibrosis, pulmonary hypertension, dementia, diabetes (type I or type II), Down syndrome,

**At least 6 months after their 2-dose primary series.**  
Eligible for mix and match

<p>People aged 18-64 years who work or live in <a href="#">high risk settings</a></p>	<p>Work or Reside in locations at increased risk for COVID-19 exposure:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● First responders (healthcare workers, firefighters, police, congregate care staff)</li> <li>● Education staff (teachers, support staff, daycare workers)</li> <li>● Homeless shelters</li> <li>● Food, agriculture, and grocery store workers</li> <li>● Manufacturing workers</li> <li>● Corrections workers</li> <li>● Public transit workers</li> </ul>
